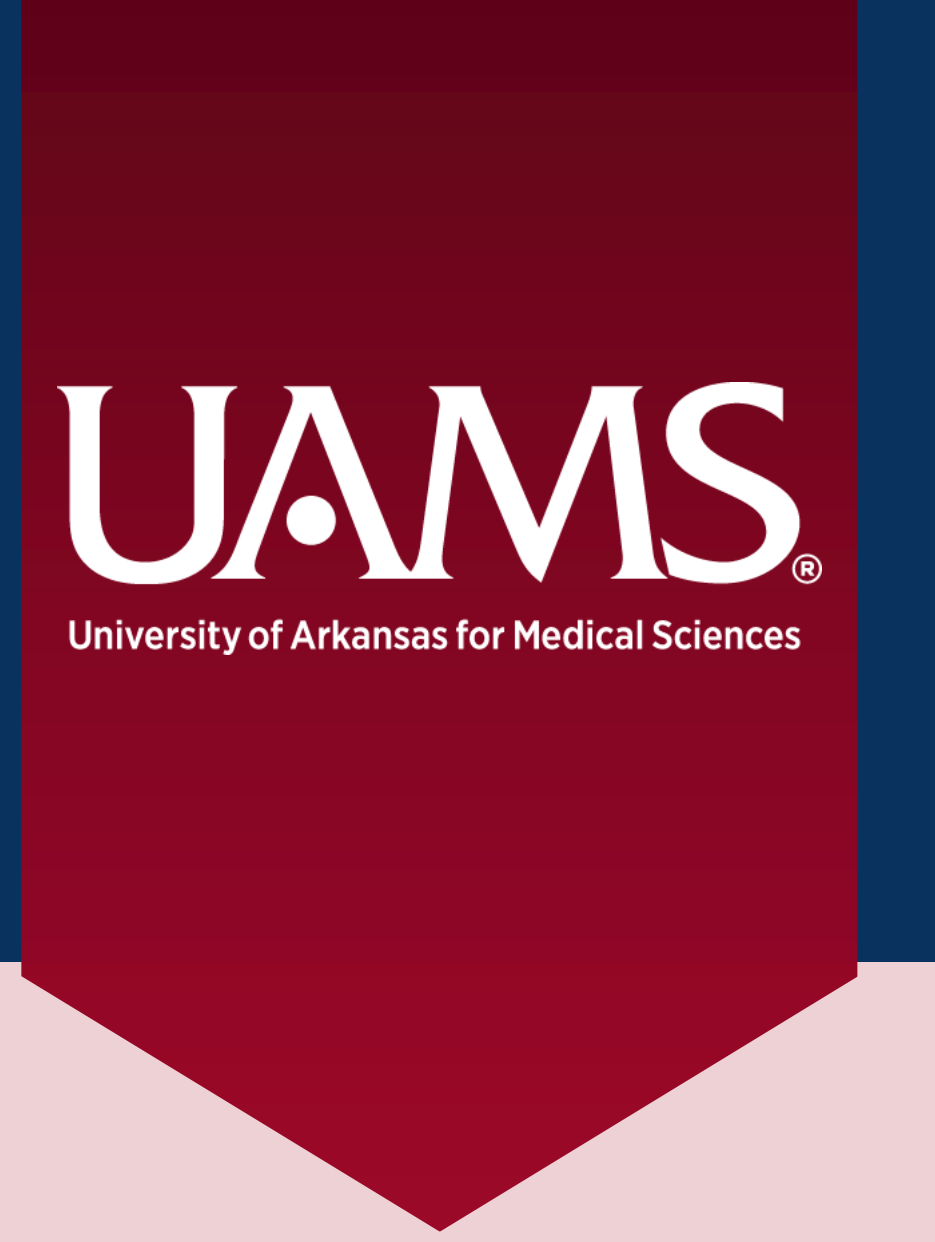


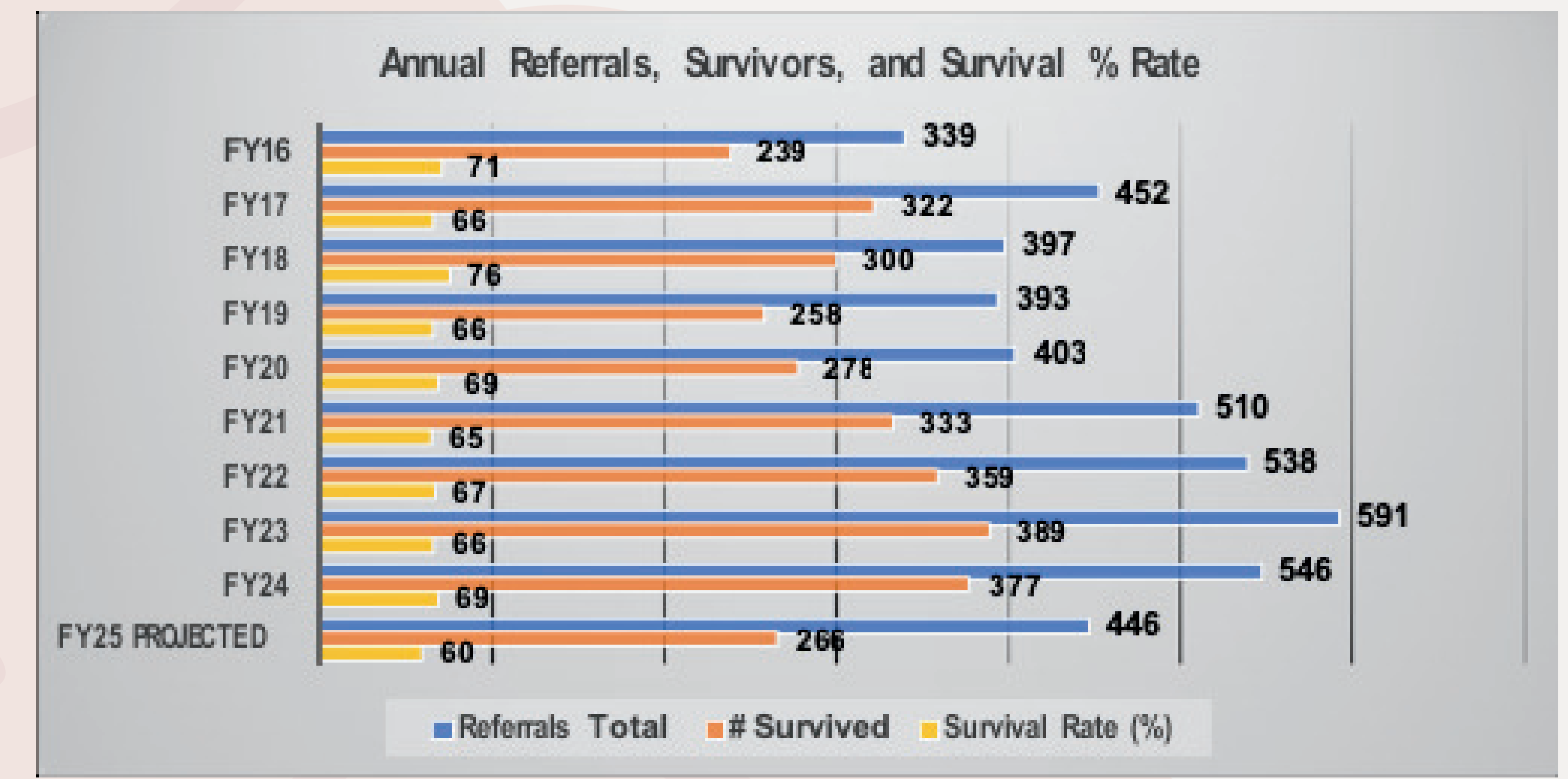
Mission statement

- **116** moderate to severe TBI referrals
- **62% survival** rate
- Projected **annual caseload: 446** (marking a potential five-year low)



Mortality & Disposition Trends

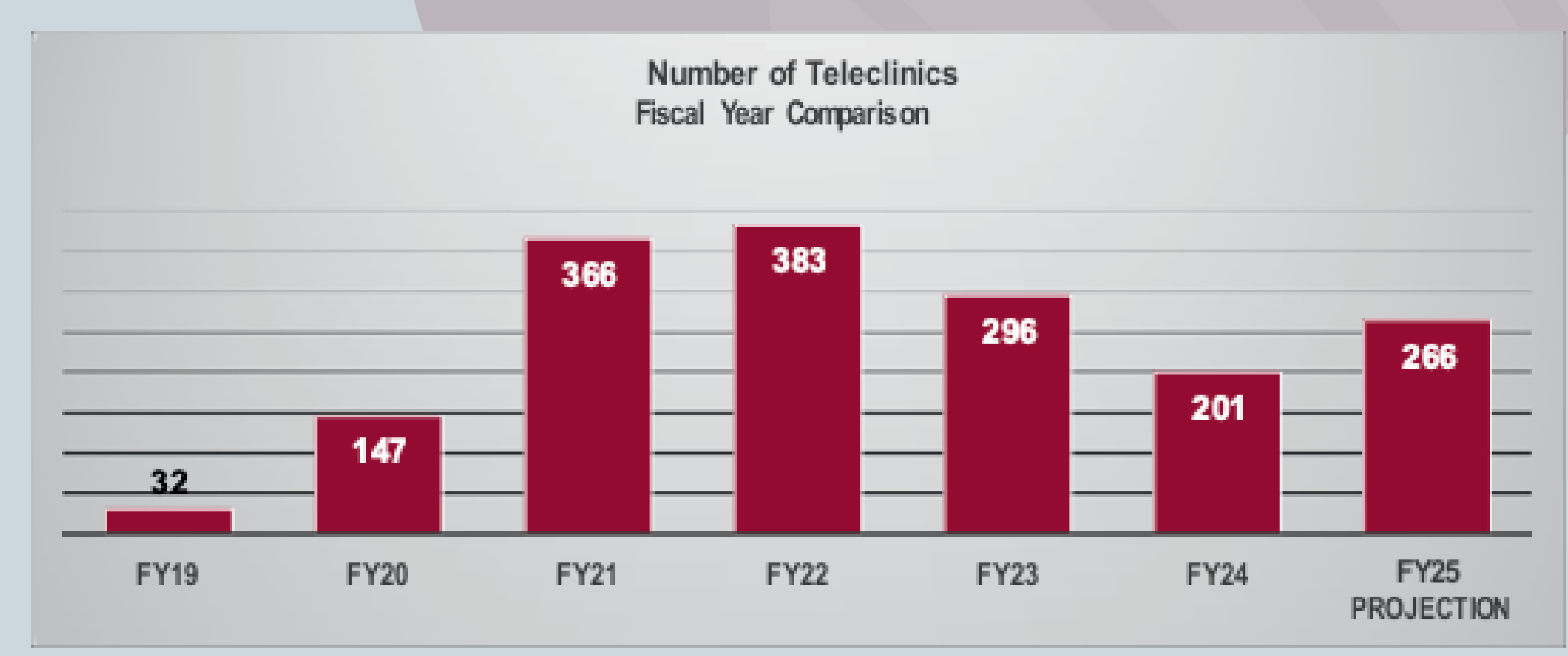
- ▢ **Decreased mortality/hospice rate**

- ▴ **Home/independent care** placements rising (6th consecutive year)
- ▣ **Long-term acute care** utilization decline (5.8% over 5 years)

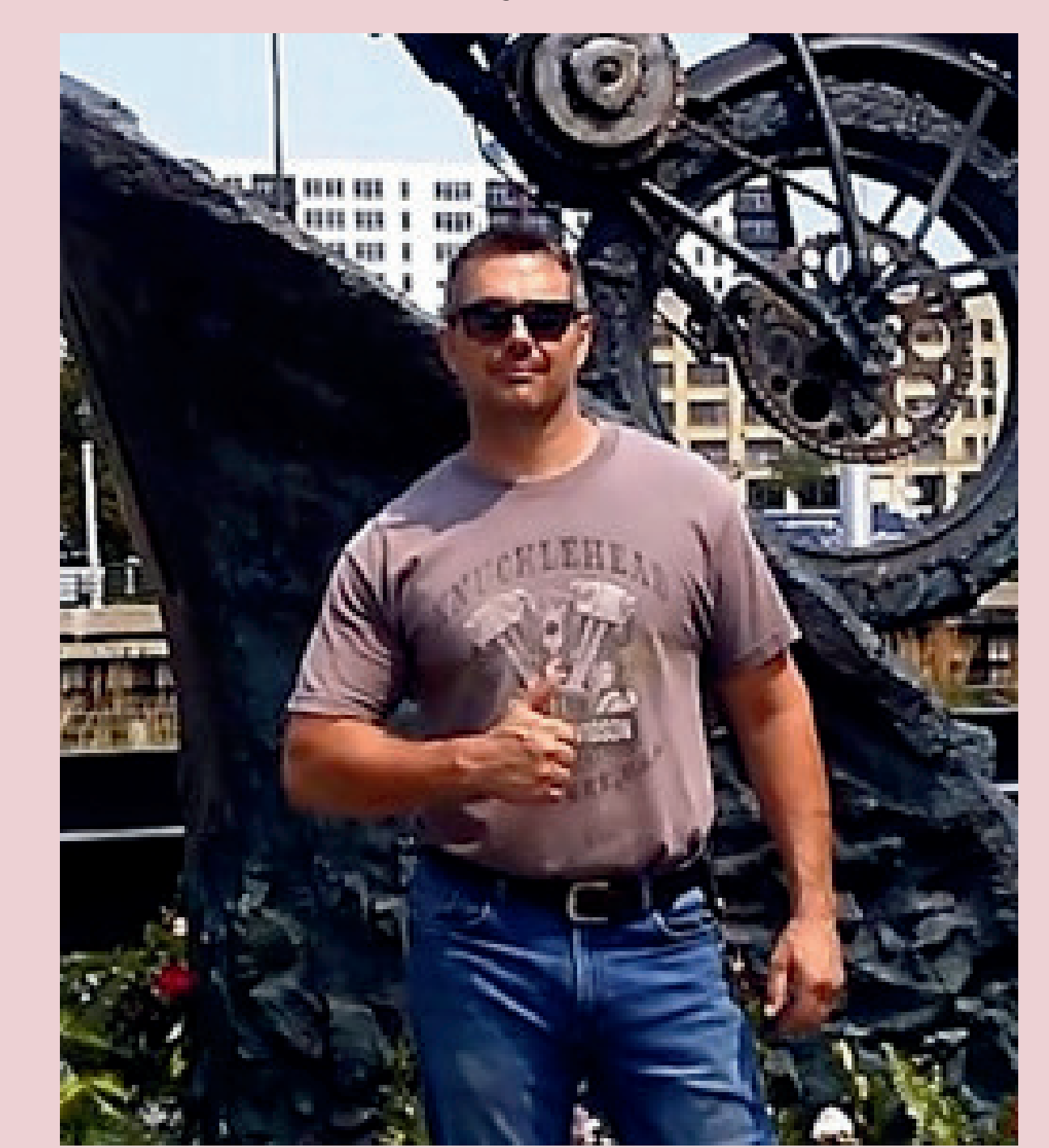

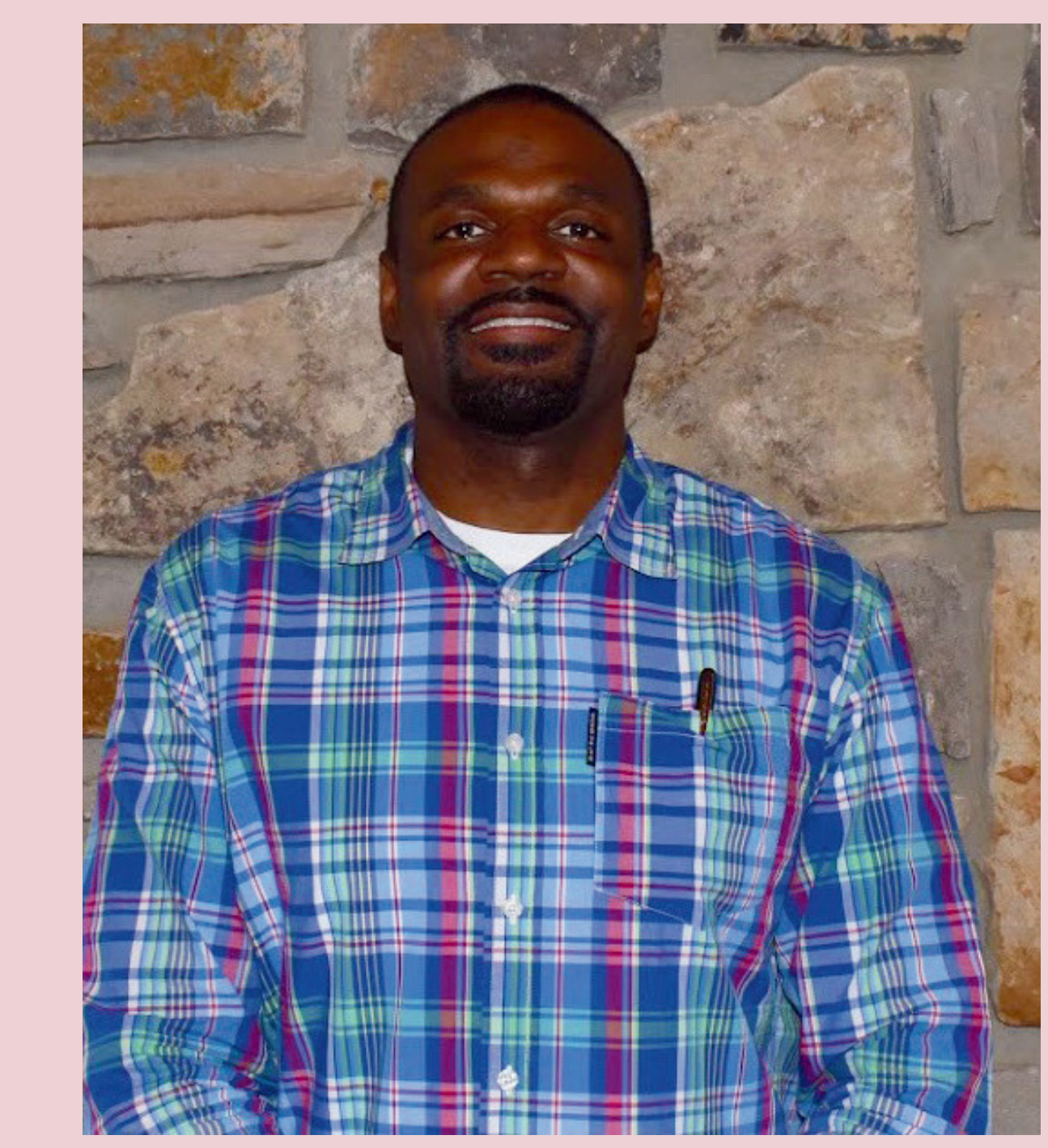
